This book tells the story of Lama Yeshe, how he met Lama Zopa Rinpoche and how they created the Foundation for the Preservation of the Mahayana Tradition (FPMT), one of the world's largest Tibetan Buddhist organizations. It begins in Tibet, where Lama was born, and moves to the Buxaduar refugee camp in West Bengal, where Rinpoche became his student, to other parts of India and Nepal, and finally to the entire world.

The author, Adele Hulse, one of Lama's earliest students, highlights his special connection with early Western Dharma seekers and skillfully weaves their intimate stories with details of where Lama went, the teachings he gave and the centers he started. It brings to life how special he was and how he connected with people from all over the world and all walks of life.

Finally, the book explains in detail how, aged 49, Lama passed away—having overcome through his spiritual power for more than ten years debilitating rheumatic heart disease that would have rendered most people bedridden, in order to spread the Dharma—and how leadership of the FPMT passed to Lama Zopa Rinpoche.

If you knew Lama, you will be reminded of his wisdom and charisma; if you did not, this is the perfect introduction.
